2. Annotation to the course

"International economic relations" is a normative discipline and mastering the main topics of the course should provide future professionals with a thorough knowledge of the peculiarities of the functioning of the international economic system and the laws of its development; understand the features of the interaction of national economies in the structure of the world economy, environment and infrastructure of international economic activity; features of the main processes of development of the modern world economy: internationalization, economic globalization and formation of integration groups; forms and methods of international economic relations and the main tools of international economic activity. This course is based on the study of political economy and microeconomics, macroeconomics, history of economics and other disciplines. The importance of the course is determined by the modern conditions of development of the world economy as a whole and the integration of Ukraine as an independent state into the world economy. The main attention is paid to current trends in the world economy, specific forms of international economic relations, the development of international economic cooperation, the problems of international economic integration and Ukraine's participation in these processes

3. The purpose and objectives of the course

The purpose of the discipline is to form a system of theoretical knowledge, skills and practical skills in the field of international economics, forms, methods and mechanisms of international economic relations and the main tools of international economic activity, world economic development and their impact on national economies, regional associations. countries of the world, as well as the acquisition of skills in the analysis of Ukraine's foreign economic policy in the process of its integration into modern world economic structures.
